2019 PEEWEE LEAGUE INFORMATION
(2006, 2007) AGE PLAYERS

Welcome to 2019 Season of Brandon Minor PeeWee Baseball.

Clover Leaf teams will play primarily on Monday and Wednesday nights

Marlins teams will play primarily on Tues/ Wed/ Fridays. The schedules may vary with some exhibition games.

Potential for 1 or 2 games on other nights, with some earlier practices. Practices/ Games will primarily be held at Simplot Diamonds. One game either Friday or Saturday night under the lights, 8:00 pm (May) or 8:30 pm (June).

Cloverleaves (Recreational) and Marlins (Competitive/Provincials) divisions. The number of teams in either division will depend on number of registrants. Players will be asked to indicate their interest in playing one or the other. There will be a limited number of spots in the Marlins division. AAA players are expected to register as "Marlins" division players. Marlins division teams will practice more frequently (1 more time during week) and will be expected to play in higher level tournaments and vs. tougher competition outside of Brandon. One PeeWee Prospects team that will play in the PeeWee Prospects tourney in Steinbach on the final weekend of July will be created from within the Marlins division. A player evaluation will occur either indoors or outdoors in the final two weeks of April. Once registration is closed, dates will be emailed to player families.

Provincials "A" Hamiota July 5-7 or "AA" Altona July 12-14

In early May, interested players in the Cloverleaves division will be invited to tryout for a high performance double roster team that will practice at 4:30 on either Tuesdays or Thursdays. This will be a team of 12 players. If two teams are permitted by the PeeWee Prospects tourney, (as in 2017) this team will be expected to be the second of the Brandon teams that participates at the PeeWee Prospects tourney at the end of July. This team will also play occasional games against the Marlins division teams. Costs for this team will be to cover tournament entry and hats.

Players must supply their own helmet to each game.

Parents who are interested in coaching please indicate so on your registration form.

Pee Wee coaches are required to complete the Respect In Sport and My First Pitch certificates as well as attend a coaching clinic.

Costs are \$200.00. Refunds: Before May 1st (full refund -\$25 admin fee), before May 31st (50% refund), after May 31st (no refund).

Registrations after the deadline will require board approval and be subject to a \$50 late fee, Special registration requests will be considered but may not be accommodated.
