

## Proposed Pilot BMBA PEEWEE 13U League Structure 2017

This winter, a committee of the 11U Mosquito and 13U Peewee directors, the President and the Executive Member at Large examined a variety of options to improve the playing experience for all players, of all abilities (House and AAA) at the 13U Peewee level. In addition to increasing the number of players taking meaningful repetitions at premium positions, this was in response to parental survey responses, trends in other regions, discussions that took place at the Baseball MB competition meeting as well as to prepare the 2005 group hosting the Western Canadian Championships in the summer of 2018. This would also increase the number of players being exposed to high performance ball by 18. Below you will find a proposed league structure for the 13U age group in 2017.

### 2 DIVISIONS – Marlins Division: 3 teams & Cloverleafs Division : 4 teams minimum.

An estimated minimum of 66 registrations would be required to have both divisions viable

**Marlins Division:** High performance option to replace season-long AAA program, Teams to enter AA tournaments, travel required. Developmental for 2018 13U AAA Westerns. AAA program would only begin June 27<sup>th</sup>

(\$200 Regular BMBA fee + minimum \$100 team fee to cover tournament entries)

Coaches selection by April 10<sup>th</sup> Evaluation night April 24<sup>th</sup> Player Draft April 25<sup>th</sup>

Season begins: May 1<sup>st</sup> \*players to be selected by coaches, High Performance Director and non-parent evaluators\*

6 game league schedule, no Standings, primarily Mon, Wed, & Thurs 1:1 games : practice

Sample schedule 3 teams: (9 weeks)

wk1 : AvB, prac, prac wk2: AvC, prac wk3: BvA, AA tourney wk4: prac, AvRussell wk5: prac, CvA wk6: BvA, prac  
wk7: AvC, AvHamiota wk8: prac, AAtourney wk9: prac, 3 team tourney

Will play minimum 2 scheduled exhibition games vs top teams from Midwest/Oildome, \*teams can schedule additional exhibition games or practices (ie. Gladstone, Russell, Strathclair, Elkhorn, Boissevain, – Based on 2015 Mosquito Prov.)

#### 3 teams of 10

Team 1- 2005/Red –“A” rep- July 7-9 Swan River – Max 4 AAA players.

Team 2- 2005-04/White & Team 3- 2005-04/Brown –Playoff to be “AA” rep- July 14-16 Altona – Max 6 AAA players on “AA” rep. APs to come from either division CLOVERLEAFS or MARLINS

#### Cloverleafs Division: (\$200 Regular BMBA fee)

Evaluation night April 24<sup>th</sup> Player Draft April 25<sup>th</sup> Season begins: May 1<sup>st</sup>

Season ends: City Championship- June 24-25 tourney : No Provincials **\*\*a DOUBLE ROSTER TEAM TO BE FORMED IN ORDER TO PLAY IN AN “A” TOURNAMENT**

9 game league schedule, Primarily Mon. & Wed. 1:1 games:practice

Sample schedule 4 teams: (9 weeks)

wk1 : AvB, prac wk2: AvC, AvD wk3: BvA, prac wk4: prac, AvRivers wk5: prac, DvA, RossburnvA wk6: AvB, prac wk7: prac DvA  
wk8: CvA prac wk9: prac + 4 game playoff tourney

1 x Fri/Sat Night Lights game (Minimum 2 BMBA scheduled Games vs Oildome, Midwest teams incl. F/SNL)

Players remain eligible to be AP'ed for “A” or “AA” provincials, 2017 13U AAA team & 2018 Western Canadians 13U AAA team

Minimum: 4 equal teams (2005s & 2004s) – 36 players required (min: 9 per team max: 10 per team)

36-40 players – 4 teams of 9 or 4 teams of 10 41-43 players – 5 teams (8, 8, 9, 9, 9)  
45-50 players – 5 teams (9 or 10 players each) 51-53 players – 6 teams (8, 8, 8, 9, 9, 9)  
54-60 players – 6 teams (9 or 10 players each)

**AAA Knights** – Team selection June 26<sup>th</sup> (or Baseball MB roster deadline)

Based on AAA coach evaluation (scouting) during games, players will be invited to play. “No tryouts”

No team practices until June 27<sup>th</sup>

Team composition (per Baseball MB rules)

- Maximum of 4 players from 2005/Red (‘A’ Rep)

- Maximum of 6 players from winner between 2004/05 Brown & 2004/05 White (“AA” rep).

Any players selected to participate as an AP player to either provincials subject to be ineligible if playing AAA

Canada Day Tourney- June 30<sup>th</sup> -July 2<sup>nd</sup> -Portage

AAA Rural Qualifier- July 21-23<sup>rd</sup> – Brandon

AAA Provincials (if qualified) – July 28-30<sup>th</sup> – St. James
